

Rights* of one man or institution vis a vis another are defined in terms of duties to God. One has a right that another not interfere with his carrying out his duties to God.
Evildoer** = One who does kakos (Gk.). Kakos encompasses both the act of harm to another by interfering with another's carrying out his duties to God captured by poneros (Gk.), and also that which is innately evil.

Commend*** = Give **epainos** (Gk.) praise, commendation to those who do well, not a roving commission for Civil Government to "do well."
